

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS
HOOD RIVER COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

The Hood River County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on **Wed, Sept 22, 2021 at 5:30pm**, to consider various amendments to Article 75 of the County Zoning Ordinance affecting property located within the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. The proposed amendments, which were initially adopted by the Columbia River Gorge Commission in October 2020, are required to be adopted by Hood River County per the National Scenic Area Act to ensure consistency between the County Zoning Ordinance and the National Scenic Area Management Plan.

The hearing is scheduled to be held in-person in the Board of County Commissioner's conference room (*1st floor*) of the County Business Administration Building, 601 State Street, Hood River, but is also being made available via Zoom for remote access.
